

How to install the CP-M1A ICC Profile on a Mac OS system

Requirements:

1. Administration rights on your PC
2. Printer driver is already installed.

3. CP-M1A color profile package – CPM1-2.icc and CPM1_G5
Profile package consist of a Gamma table and an ICC file.

Instruction:


Change gamma table

Replace the original CP-M1_G5 with new csv file included in the profile package.


CP-M1_G5 original file is located at `/Libraries/Printers/MITSUBISHI/filter`

Rename original CPM1_G5.csv with CPM1_G5.orig


Add new CPM1_G5.csv file to the same directory.




Add the color profile CPM1-2.icc file to /Libraries/ColorSync/Profiles.



Associating the color profile to CP-M1A printer. Open Mac's Color Sync application, highlight MITSUBISHI CP-M1, click the Current Profile icon, and select "Other". Browse and select CP-M1-2.icc.



Apply the ICC file on the printing dialog windows of CP-M1A. Select Printer Feature and enable the Color Conversion.



Finally click Print and set the ColorSync setting to Automatic.
